- Work to get them exemplified quickly!

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Recruiting New Members: Proof of Concept



- Proof of concept is virtually identical to a traditional church drive
- Key difference: How you sign up new E-members

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Recruiting New Members: Proof of Concept (cont.)



- With proof of concept, the council is completing the E-member application, with the applicant's permission
- Timely follow-up is essential- Make sure the candidate clicks the email link

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Recruiting New Members: Proof of Concept (cont.)



- Don't ignore other key aspects of successful recruitment drives
- Proof of concept method can be used at all of your events

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Engaging Your Members



- Assign new members a council mentor. Mentor guidelines are available on the state website.
- Get them involved in council programs that interest them
- Remember, an engaged knight is a happy knight who remains an active knight!

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Affiliate Member Initiative



- Despite your best efforts, you will have members who become disengaged
- Rather than expressly resigning, many will simply stop paying dues and stop responding.
- These may be candidates for the AMI



Affiliate Member Initiative (con't.)

- The AMI is still available and allows you to remove inactive members from your roster.
- The Guidebook AND Affiliate List Submission Process are posted on the Engagement and Development portion of the state website



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Affiliate Member Initiative (con't.)

- Those exempted from dues are not eligible for the AMI.
- Inactive insurance members are now eligible for the AMI
- A member can not request affiliate status and it should not be offered





Affiliate Member Initiative (con't.)

- When compiling your AMI list, follow the instructions to the letter- Supreme will not process lists that do not comport to the guidelines
- When your list has been reviewed by the necessary council officers it is sent to your DD
- The DD will submit to Supreme
