The State Council Midyear Meeting will be held on Saturday, January 17, 2026, at St. Bede's Kaplan Hall immediately following Mass and Adoration at St. Bede's Catholic Church. Mass will begin at 0800 with Adoration following the Mass, then proceed to Kaplan Hall for meeting. The recommended attire for the meeting is jacket and tie. For your convenience, there will be a table in the church commons prior to Mass to get credentials checked and hand stamped, which hopefully will expedite checking in at the meeting.

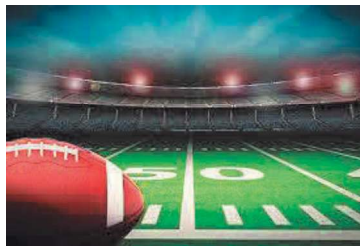
